I firmly resolve, with the help of Thy grace, to confess my sins, to do penance, and to amend my life. Amen.

To thee, O Blessed Joseph, do we have recourse in our tribulation. And having implored the help of thy thrice-holy spouse, we confidently invoke thy patronage also. By that charity wherewith thou wast united to the Immaculate Virgin Mother of God, and by that fatherly affection with which thou didst embrace the Child Jesus, we beseech thee and we humbly pray that thou wouldst look graciously upon the inheritance which Jesus Christ hath purchased by His Blood, and wilt assist us in our needs by thy power and strength. Thus, over many centuries she has built up a wealth of wholesome, time-honoured Catholic Prayers for every need and desire. Catholics know these prayers by heart and are able to recite them when the need presents itself.

PRAYER BEFORE A CRUCIFIX

Behold, O good and sweetest Jesus, I cast myself upon my knees in Thy sight, and with the most fervent desire of my soul I pray and beseech Thee to impress upon my heat lively sentiments of faith, hope, and charity,

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with true repentance for my sins and a most firm desire of amendment: whilst with deep affection and grief of soul I consider within myself and mentally contemplate Thy five most precious Wounds, having before mine eyes that which David the prophet, long ago spoke in Thine own person concerning Thee, my Jesus: *They have pierced my hands and my feet; they have numbered all my bones.* (Psalm XXI:17-18)

Then say one Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory be for the intentions of the Holy Father. You may gain a 10 years indulgence by reciting this prayer piously before an image of Christ Crucified. You may gain a Plenary indulgence the same way if you have also confessed and communicated and prayed for the intentions of the Holy Father the Pope. (Feb. 2, 1934)

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost. Amen.

THE OUR FATHER

I confess to Almighty God, to blessed Mary ever Virgin, to blessed Michael the Archangel, to the holy Apostles Peter and Paul, and to all the saints, that I have sinned exceedingly in though, word, and deed, through my fault, through m fault, through my most grievous fault. Therefore, I beseech blessed Mary ever Virgin, blessed Michael the Archangel, blessed John the Baptist, the holy Apostles Peter and Paul, and all the saints to pray to the Lord our God for me.

May the Almighty God have mercy on me, and forgive me my sins, and bring me to life everlasting. Amen. May the Almighty and merciful Lord grant me pardon, absolution, and remission of all my sins. Amen.

SPIRITUAL COMMUNION

O My God, I love Thee above all things with my whole heart and soul, and I believe that Thou art truly present in the Blessed Sacrament of the Altar. O Lord, since I cannot now receive Thee in Holy Communion, come at least spiritually into my heart. Permit not that I should ever be separated from Thee. Amen.

ANIMA CHRISTI

Soul of Christ, be my sanctification.
Body of Christ, be my salvation.
Blood of Christ, fill all my veins.
Water from the Side of Christ,
wash out my stains.
Passion of Christ, my comfort be.
O good Jesus, listen to me.
